

## Clean Motion and Bosch in collaboration to improve craftsman and facility services in cities

**Property and craftsmen services in cities are becoming increasingly challenging for both the property owners and for companies that carry out the work and services. That's why Clean Motion and Robert Bosch AB are now collaborating to develop a concept for a smarter and more sustainable solution.**

"Managing a service job with reduced emissions requires smart and different solutions for the urban environment. That's why tomorrow's electric vehicles for property management and service need to be small, spacious, and energy-efficient at the same time. It's time to change the way property and craftsmen-service transport is done in the cities," says Christoffer Sveder, Commercial Director at Clean Motion.

The goal of the collaboration is to create a modern end-to-end solution built on a business model that truly supports professional craftsmen in the city environment. The starting point is Clean Motion's electric vehicle Re:volt, which will be adapted and optimized to handle tools and materials in an integrated and efficient way.

"We know that companies providing services in inner-city areas face major challenges in the transition to sustainable urban development. Solutions are needed to meet the requirements of low-speed and zero-emission zones as well as face the complexity of parking. Together we are now developing a sustainable and modern solution at a lower cost," says Ralf Mårtensson, Business Development Manager at Robert Bosch AB.

### Together with craftsmen for craftsmen

Clean Motion and Robert Bosch AB are now looking for candidates in construction and property services to co-create the concept. The aim is to develop a solution that the market is currently lacking. The work will continue until fall when the live tests are expected to start.

### About Re:volt

Re:volt is Clean Motion's latest vehicle for "last-mile" deliveries and urban environments. It has 5% of the CO<sub>2</sub>e footprint compared to other delivery vehicles. The solar cells on the roof allow for a minimal need of charging infrastructure, which both extends the vehicle's range and lifetime.

The Clean Motion go-to-market strategy for Re:volt is based on the inclusion of customers and partners for the final steps of the development phase. In this process, the company has invited certain companies to finalize the vehicle for various use cases and business verticals. The validation will take place by the rollout of commercial pilots, starting in the second half of 2022.
